BULLY PREVENTION:

Have you ever been mean to someone and wish you could take it back? How would you fix what you said?

If a friend is pressuring you to do or say something you don't want to do, what are some ways you can say 'no'?

Is there a kid in your class or school that is mean to you or others? Why do you think they're mean?

How can you tell what someone is feeling just by looking at their body language or facial expression?

BULLYING AND TEASING

If a classmate was being bullied, what could you say to them?

If you saw your friend bully someone else, what could you say to your friend to get them to stop?

If you saw something bad happen at school, who could you tell?

What could you do or say if someone says they don't like your glasses or shoes or shirt?

If you hear a rumor about a friend, what could you say to the person telling you the rumor?

When would you go tell a teacher that something was happening to you or a classmate that doesn't feel right.

If a friend says you have to do something you don't want to do or they won't be your friend anymore, what could you say or do?

Has a classmate ever teased you or called you a name? How did it make you feel?

Who in your class/grade is a good friend to others? What makes them a good friend?

What's a compliment you gave to a classmate today? What are 2 compliments you can give to someone else tomorrow?

What are the names of 2 kids you can invite to play with you? Why would you choose them?

Do you know anyone in your class/grade that is having a hard time at school? What could you do to make it easier for them?
