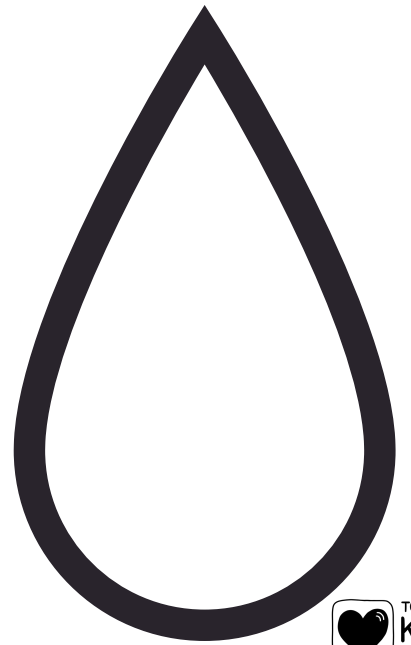
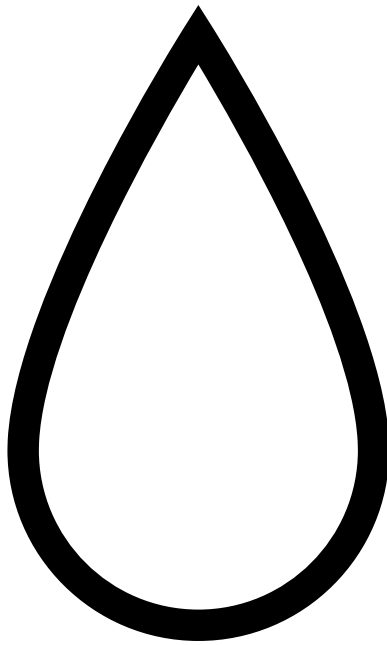
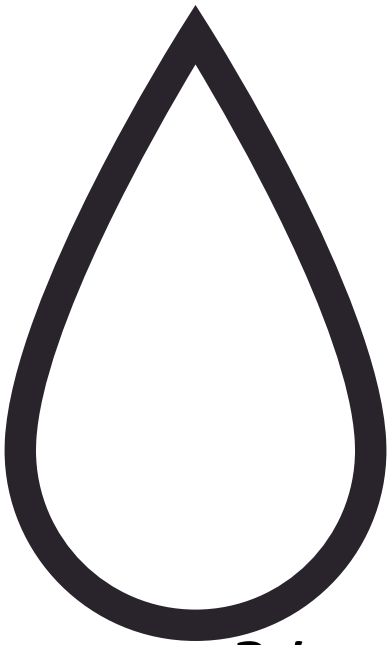
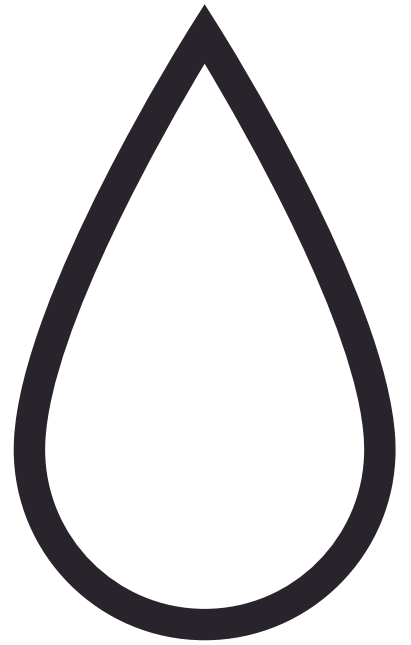
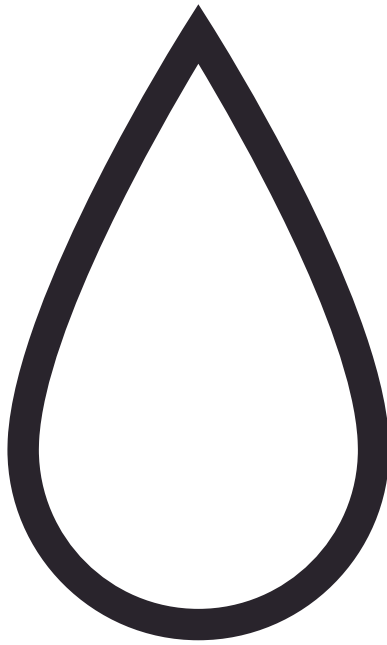
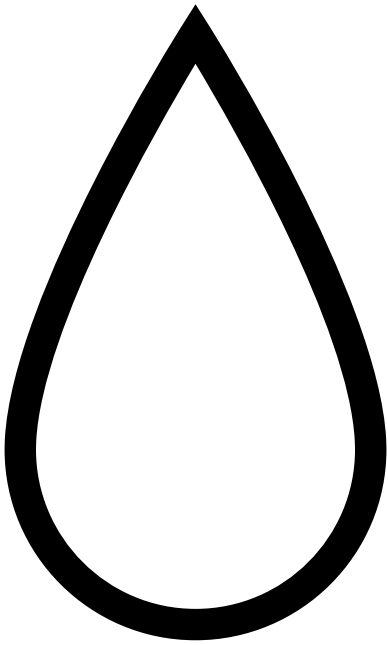
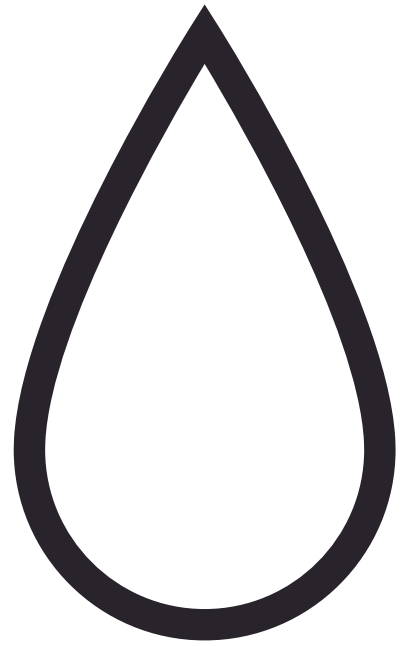
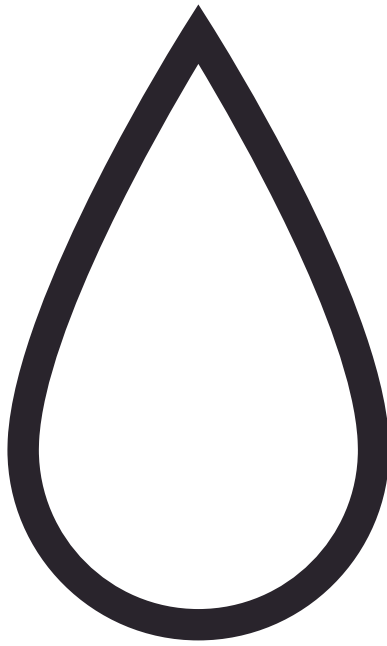
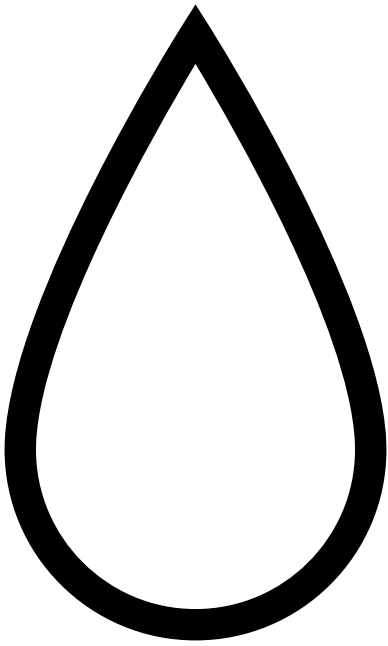
1. Print and cut out the umbrella of your choice, the letters, and several sheets of the raindrops on card stock (or use pre-cut letters).

4. See how many raindrops your class can collect in a week or in a month.



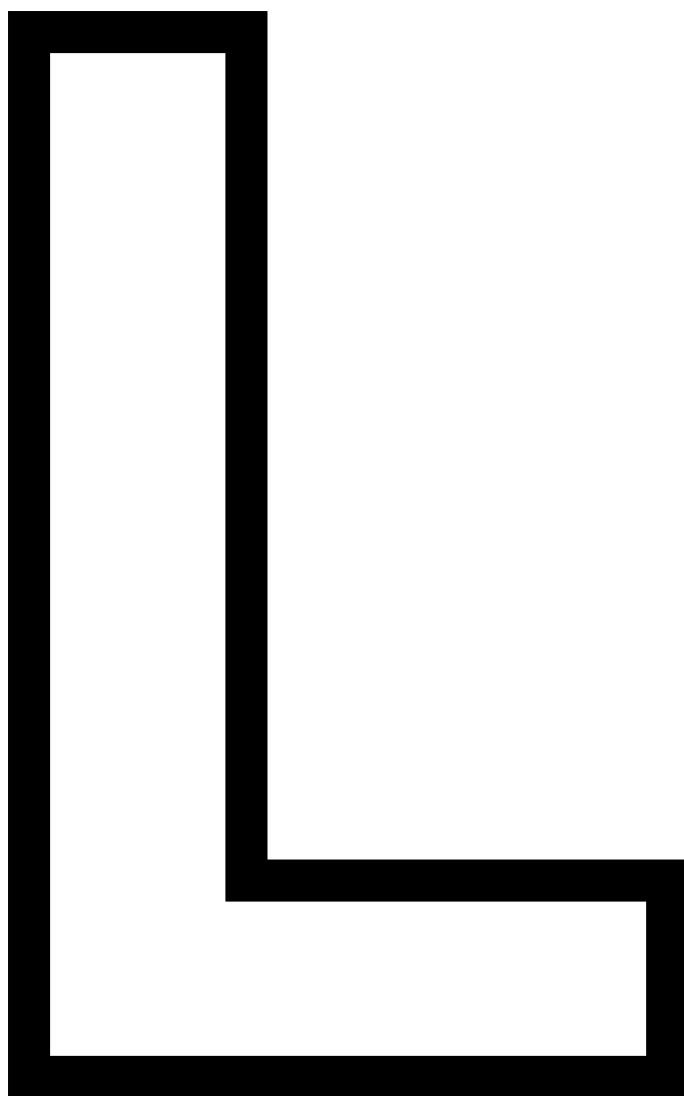


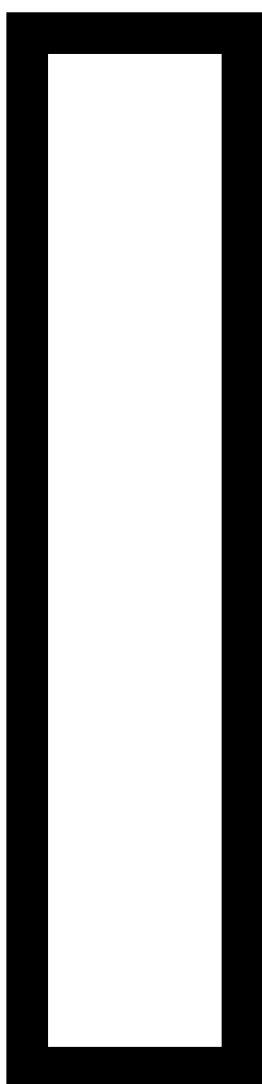


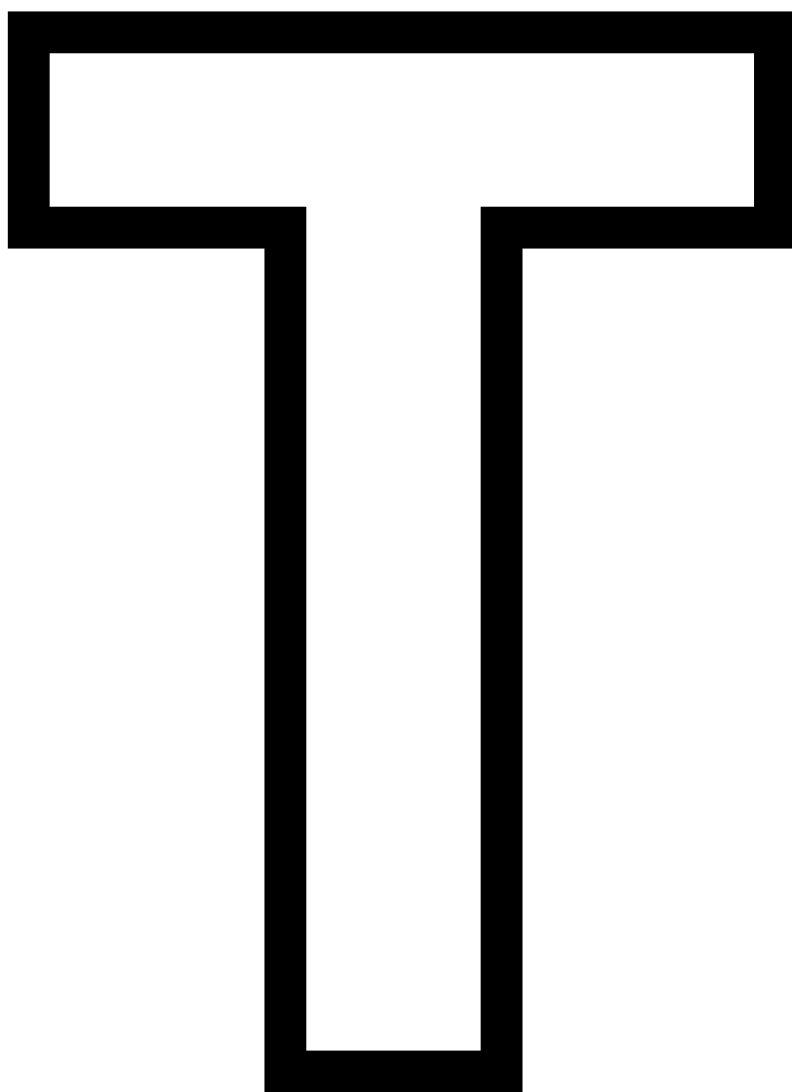


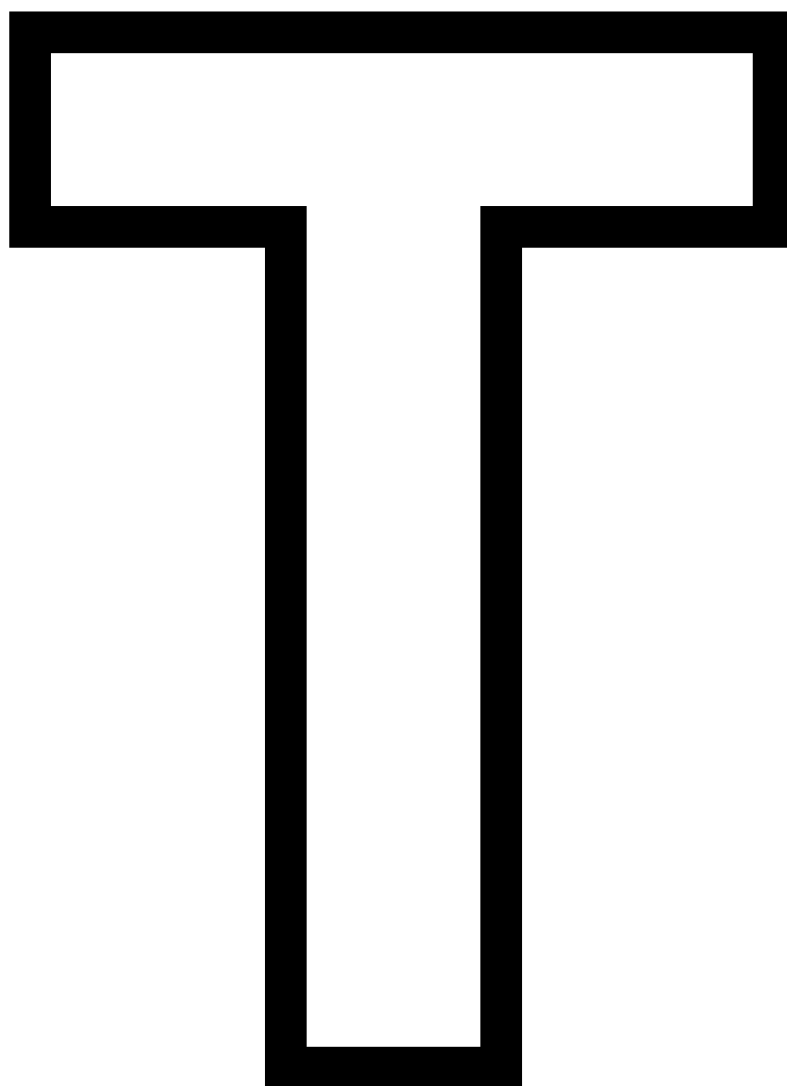


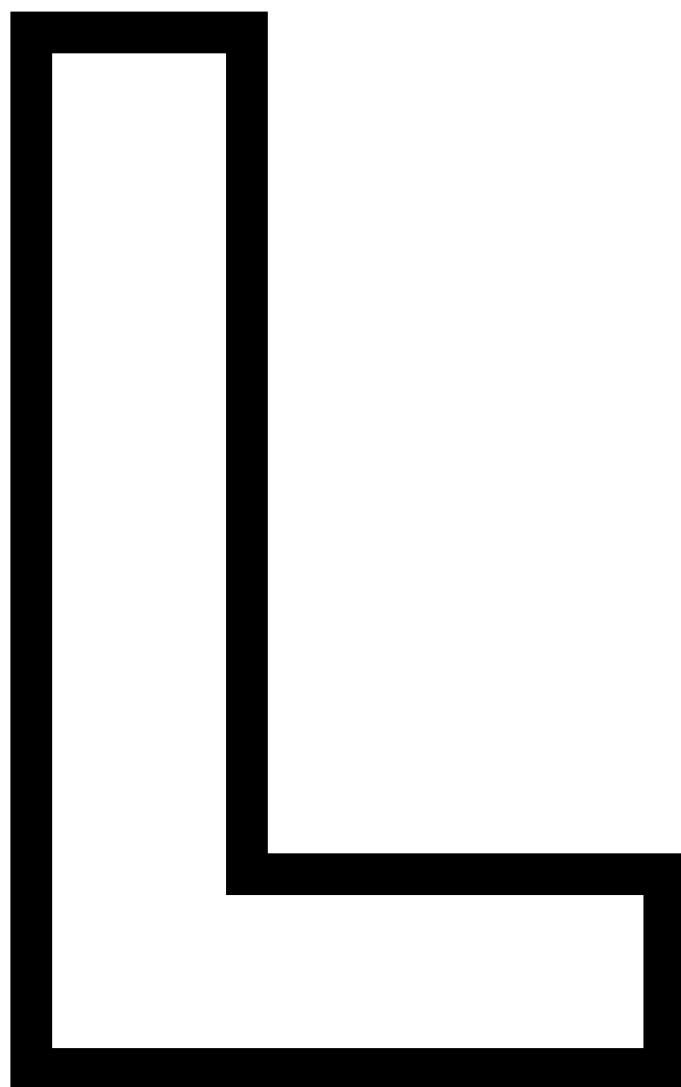
