

How to Use These Printable Valentines

- 1. Print out the version you wish you to use, color or black and white on cardstock paper. These are perfect for Valentine's Day or just because. You can print out all of these so there are different Valentine cards OR print out the same page multiple times to give the same Valentine.
- 2. Kids can write their friends' names on the cards and can write or dictate a message underneath and then sign their name.
- 3. If you use the black and white version, kids can color in the picture and color in their bubble words.
- 4. Encourage kids to write these for every student in the class, even if they're not friends.
- 5. If you're a classroom teacher, you can encourage your kids who don't have Valentines to use these for their classmates so they can also pass out something.
